

Responsible Sourcing Policy

Vitapro and its subsidiaries contribute to the sustainability and conservation of the environment, making progress aligned with the challenges and objectives of sustainable development (ODS), the demands of the industry and the Company's Sustainability Roadmap, to address climate and nature impacts through the responsible supply of its ingredients, making the following commitments:

- Our suppliers are legally incorporated and operate in a socially and environmentally responsible manner, in compliance with the local laws and regulations of the country of production and our Supplier Code of Conduct.
- The ingredients we use are selected, analyzed and approved according to the technical criteria of quality, safety, traceability and sustainability established by Vitapro.
- We do not purchase or use fishmeal or fish oil from illegal, unreported and/or unregulated fishing. Furthermore, the species used are not classified in the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species as vulnerable, endangered, or critically endangered.
- We prioritize the purchase of fishmeal and fish oil from responsible sources and/or certified sustainable fisheries under the ISEAL framework and encourage responsible environmental management of small midwater fisheries.
- We do not use vegetable ingredients that come from crops grown in areas of the Amazon Biome or that cause deforestation of tropical rainforests, promoting a deforestation-free supply chain and conversion aimed at protecting forests and natural ecosystems.
- We strive to source our vegetable ingredients from low-risk sources, whose crops maintain the best recognized agricultural practices for the management of water, soil, nutrients, agrochemicals and organic fertilizers, and where appropriate measures are taken to minimize and mitigate any negative environmental impact.
